Go sailing, fishing, golfing, standup paddle boarding, kite surfing, mountain biking, camping, hiking, climbing and then... take a breath ...and enjoy the view!



There is something spiritual about witnessing the majestic humpback whale in full flight. Cruise on the humpback highway, get up close and personal to the whales and wild dolphins.



Evening: Head back to Birubi for a early evening camel ride along the dunes towards a stunning beach sunset.


Stay at the Mantra

This easy walk on a paved track around the lower slopes of Tomaree Head brings you face-to-face with local military heritage – World War II Gun emplacements, built in 1941.

# **BIG ROCKY**

Distance: 1.4km (one way)

Time: 30 minutes each way

Difficulty: Medium

A sandy track leading to a rocky headland ideal at low tide.

# **WRECK BEACH**

Distance: 1km (one way)
Time: 20 minutes each way

Difficulty: Medium

This easy walk to Wreck Beach, through a lush coastal Angophora forest, leads onto a small cove with beautiful sand and open views of the ocean.


## MORNA POINT
